

PRAYING FOR YOUR ADULT CHILDREN --- REBEKAH BEENE

God spoke and said You're fighting the wrong person. I knew what He meant. We do not have authority over our adult children. But we do have authority over the spirits that try to control their lives. More recently God told me as I was pouring my heart out to Him asking "why haven't you answered yet?" Why not ask God everything you think, He already knows. Here are wonderful Scriptures to pray over your children. I would suggest if you don't have a child (adult or otherwise) in trouble now, pray them over them anyway. Protection is better than retrieval.

All your children shall be taught by the Lord, and great shall be the peace of your children. Isaiah 54:13

"And as for me, this is my covenant with them," says the Lord: "My Spirit that is upon you, and my words that I have put in your mouth, shall not depart out of your mouth, or out of the mouth of your offspring, or out of the mouth of your children's offspring," says the Lord, "from this time forth and forevermore." Isaiah 59:21

The children of your servants shall dwell secure; their offspring shall be established before you. Psalm 102:28
